ARROW SIGN POLICY

The Town of Washington allows residential use arrow signs at various locations throughout the township subject to the following conditions:

1. Arrow signs must conform to the design, size, printing and color as shown in the diagram below. Non-conforming signs will be removed without notice.
2. Installation of arrow signs will be the responsibility of the sign owner and subject to the availability of space at each location. Screws are recommended. Please install in an even and uniform manner with the existing signs. Do not remove existing signs without the permission of the owner.
3. You are responsible for the upkeep of your sign. Arrow signs with peeling paint or illegible lettering will be removed without notice. Broken signs will be removed without notice. If changing residence in the town or moving away from the area it is your responsibility to remove your sign. Abandoned signs will be removed without notice.
4. Arrow signs are for residential or commercial directional use only. Advertising signs are not allowed. Inappropriate or offensive signs will be removed without notice.
5. The Town of Washington will assume no liability associated with the installation, upkeep, damage to, and removal of signs. Sign owner assumes all risks associated with their individual arrow sign.
6. This sign policy will not apply to arrow signs erected on State trunk highways located within the boundaries of the township. WisDOT permits are required for those locations and can be obtained from the Vilas County Highway Department.
